Vendor usage reports are due 90 days before the bid(s) expire. You are given 30 days to complete the usage report and submit it to the PACA Team.


All ITBs include the following language that usage reports are required as requested by the Jefferson County Commission Purchasing Division. The report is to include the purchase/spend information for Jefferson County Commission Departments, Jefferson County Commission Entities, and the Purchasing Association of Central Alabama (PACA) and <u>submit the information for the time period requested to the Jefferson County Purchasing Department: Regina Mitchell, Administrative Analyst/PACA, mitchellr@jccal.org.</u>

USAGE REPORT (Bid language included in all ITBs)

At no cost to the County, the Contractor shall be required to provide quarterly, bi-annual, and annual usage reports or reports as requested by Jefferson County Commission Purchasing Division. The reports will include purchase/spend information for; Jefferson County Commission Departments, Jefferson County Commission Entities (EMA, Personnel Board, Sheriff's Office), and Purchasing Association of Central Alabama partners. Report categories will include, but will not be limited to customer name, date of purchase, item description, quantity, dollar value, aggregate sales to date for each customer, customer savings, and other such information as requested by the Jefferson County Purchasing Division. Excel and PDF are the preferred electronic media for these reports. Failure to provide the requested reports will be deemed as an event of default.

If you receive an order or quote request from an organization stating they are a **PACA Member/Partner**, make sure they receive **PACA pricing**.

The City of Birmingham's new City Walk is open. Eight years in the making, City Walk BHAM offers everything from pickleball courts and skateboarding to dog parks and relaxing gardens. It stretches from 15th Street North to 25th Street North under the 59/20 Interstate. Each block has its own feature for citizens to enjoy. Below are highlights of all the exciting features of the city walk.

- Block A (15th to 16th Streets North): Artificial surface sports and recreation fields, challenge course, amphitheater, civil rights story zone, gathering space, and 1/4-mile walking trail
- Block B (16th to 18th Streets North): Roller skating rink, food trucks, activity zone, skate park
- Block C (18th to 19th Streets North): Performance space, outdoor classroom, parking
- Block D (19th Street to Richard Arrington Jr Boulevard North): Outdoor stage, central gathering space, garden path, water feature, restrooms, security office, information
- Block E (Richard Arrington Jr Boulevard to 22nd Street North): Marketspace
- Block F (22nd to 23rd Streets North): Beer and wine garden, garden path
- Block G (23rd to 24th Streets North): Dog park, pickleball courts, restrooms, and parking
- Block H (24th to 25th Streets North): Gateway pond, open green space, playground, restroom, and pavilion

This is an exciting moment for the Birmingham community. This project is a true reflection of what community is all about, delivering a vision for growth in an extraordinary way that benefits everyone.
