

Building Community in Irondale By Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr.

Since taking office as the Mayor of Irondale on November 2, 2020, we've hit the ground running to implement "The E Plan," which consists of five Es. One of our immediate priorities was **employee empowerment** and creating a positive workplace culture in our City. We were able to pass eight resolutions to protect and provide for our employees, including a 3 percent pay increase, COVID-19 hazardous pay, and additional holidays.

Irondale is on the move when it comes to **economic development**. We have two companies that recently announced multimillion-dollar expansion projects in our City: Motion Industries and Weathertech. New home construction is taking off with two significant new subdivisions being developed, including one that will feature 172 homes built for rent. Plans are moving forward for a new grocery store at the Grants Mill/Old Leeds Road intersection and a transformative "Project X" in talks to locate along the corridor. Irondale is also building its brand as the region's luxury automotive capitol. In April, Echo Park Automotive opened, a new, used car concept developed by Sonic Automotive.





Although our schools are part of the Jefferson County School System, our City is investing in **education** like never before. We've allocated \$100,000 in this year's budget for our schools to go directly towards resources and opportunities for Irondale's youth.

To improve the **environment** in our City, we hosted a trash amnesty week in each council district to pick up large items not usually serviced by our garbage collection. We also allocated \$1.5 million this year towards road paving and sidewalks.

Eco-Tourism is a targeted growth area for our City. I've been working with leaders in the hiking and cycling communities to find ways to make our City more attractive. Plans are underway for a significant renovation to Ruffner Park. We are also kicking off our Blueprint Irondale Comprehensive Plan update to engage citizens on what they would like to see in Irondale's future.

My mission is simple—to build community in the City of Irondale. Our team actively engages citizens through monthly newsletters, calling and texting software, virtual and in-person town hall meetings, neighborhood canvassing, and food giveaways.

We hope you'll visit the City of Irondale soon and become a part of our community!




